Equitation- Judged on the correctiveness of the riders seat.

Pleasure- Judged on the equitation of the rider and the performance of the horse.

Horsemanship- Judged on the equitation of the rider and the performance of the horse.
The rider may be asked to perform and additional task.

Hunter-Judged on the performance of the combination of horse and rider.

1. \$10.00 per class
1. Riders entered into the walk/trot divisions may not cross over to any canter division.
2. The judge's decision is final.
3. Martingales are not permitted in any flat class, however they are permitted in the jumping classes.

PRIZE INFORMATION

1. Ribbons will be awarded to the top six riders in each class in all divisions. A prize will also be awarded to the first place rider.
2. Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons will be awarded to all divisions.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Proof of negative Coggins Test is required.
2. All riders are required to wear protective head gear when mounted.
3. Schooling is permitted in authorized areas only.
4. NO DOGS ALLOWED.
5. There is NO SMOKING anywhere on PREC property.
6. There will be a \$20.00 fee for returned checks to PREC.
7. PREC reserves the right to combine or cancel any class if there are less than 4 riders.
